**Subject:** 2020 Escalation Year –Region 3

### **SUPPLEMENT**

This supplemental filing is being made as a result of Commission staff review. GSWC has made minor corrections to the tariff sheets. This filing will replace Advice Letter No. 1804-W in its entirety.

### **PURPOSE**

This advice letter submittal seeks to implement Escalation Year 2020 water rates, as authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), for the Region 3 CSAs. GSWC’s request is being made pursuant to Decision No. 19-05-044, dated May 30, 2019 for GSWC’s General Rate Case Application (Application No. 17-07-010). Specifically, Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 19-05-044 states,

*1. The joint motion filed on August 15, 2018, for the adoption of the Settlement Agreement, is granted. The Settlement Agreement attached to this decision as Appendix A is adopted.*

Ordering Paragraph No. 4 states,

*4. For escalation years 2020 and 2021, Golden State Water Company must file Tier 1 advice letters in conformance with General Order 96-B proposing new revenue requirements and corresponding revised tariff schedules for each ratemaking area in this proceeding. The advice letters must follow the escalation procedures set forth in the Revised Rate Case Plan for Class A Water Utilities adopted in Decision 07-05-062 and must include supporting workpapers. Golden State Water Company must file for rate reduction if the escalation procedures result in a rate reduction due to negative rate base growth, inflation factors, or customer growth. The revised tariff schedule must take effect on January 1, 2020 and January 1, 2021, respectively and apply to services rendered on and after their effective dates. The proposed revised revenue requirements and rates must be reviewed by the Commission's Water Division. The Water Division must inform the Commission if it finds that the revised rates do not conform to the Revised Rate Case Plan, this decision, or other Commission decisions, and if so, reject the filing.*

#### **COMPLIANCE**

GSWC is filing this advice letter to implement rates for Escalation Year 2020. GSWC is authorized to increase rates in its Region 3 CSAs by \$4,433,017 or 3.60%. Accordingly, GSWC has computed the 2020 Escalation Year using the escalation methodology set forth in the Revised Rate Case Plan, the escalation factors as of September 2019 as published by the Public Advocates Office Energy Cost of Service Branch, and the current CPI-U available at the time of filing.

#### **RATE OF RETURN**

The following summary lists the Recorded, Authorized, and Pro-forma rates of return in GSWC's Region 3 CSAs for twelve months ending September 2019. The pro forma rate of return is calculated in accordance with guidelines provided by the Water Division.

<b>Authorized</b>	<b>7.91%</b>
<b>Recorded</b>	<b>9.03%</b>
<b>Pro forma</b>	<b>7.72%</b>

As shown above, the Pro-forma return is less than the Authorized rate of return. As such, no earnings adjustment is required for the proposed 2020 water rate increase.

#### **BILL IMPACT**

The monthly bill of a residential customer on Schedule No. R3-1-R with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter, using 12 Ccfs will increase by \$2.07 or 3.51%.

The monthly bill of a customer on Schedule No. R3-1-NR with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter, using 69 Ccfs will increase by \$9.72 or 3.51%.

Two copies of detailed workpapers supporting the proposed rate increase and rate calculations are being supplied to the Commission Staff under a separate cover.

### TIER DESIGNATION

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

### EFFECTIVE DATE

As directed, the effective date of these revised tariffs shall be January 1, 2020.

### NOTICE

Customer Notice: This is a Tier 1 advice letter that does not require customer notification, as provided in Water Industry Rule 7.3.1 of General Order 96-B. GSWC will include a bill message on the customer's first bill after the increase goes into effect to inform its Region 3 customers of this rate increase.

### RESPONSE OR PROTEST

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this Advice Letter (AL). When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform DWA, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

**REPLIES**

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL. Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

4. Water Service Fee: Following the Effective Date of Advice Letter 1217-W, Forest Lawn shall pay a monthly fee to GSW as payment towards the Fixed Costs ("Water Service Fee"), which shall be determined as follows:

Water Service Fee. The Agreement attached to Advice Letter No. 1217-W contains as Exhibit A, a schedule of Fixed Costs supporting the rates specified in GSW's Tariff Schedule R3-1 as of January 1, 2006. If the Effective Date occurs while Fixed Costs remain the same, Forest Lawn will pay an initial monthly Water Service Fee of two thousand, four, hundred forty-six dollars (\$2,446) for GSW's maintaining a potable water connection for use by the Cemetery for irrigation purposes, which the Parties agree is an accurate determination of Forest Lawn's proportional share of said Fixed Costs.

Periodic Adjustments. The amount of the Water Service Fee shall be adjusted, as necessary, concurrently with the effective date of each future change in GSW's CPUC-approved tariff Schedule No. R3-1 or successor tariff to reflect the Cemetery's then proportional share of Fixed Costs. The methodology for said adjustments shall be the same as that set forth in Exhibit A to the Agreement attached to Advice Letter No. 1217-W.
