SPECIAL CONDITIONS

9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission a surcharge will be applied to customer bills for the remainder of a 20-year loan obligation that began in March 2013 to repay a \$8.6 million loan Golden State Water Company received under the Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 from the California Department of Public Health to fund the Meter Installation and Retrofit Program in the Arden-Cordova District, pursuant to Commission Resolution W-4810. The surcharges below will go into effect on the effective date of Advice Letter 1756-W.

10. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.137 per Ccf based on a 12-month amortization period, is to be added to the Quantity Rate, beginning on July 31, 2023 as indicated in Advice Letter 1898-W. The surcharge may be recalibrated annually, if necessary. This surcharge will recover the under collection in the MCBA Balancing Account. (L)(P)

11. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a one-time refund in the amount listed below will be applied to customer bills on the effective date of Advice Letter 1904-W. This refund includes the over-collection in the 2018 Cost of Capital Memorandum Account. (N)
