This Tier 1 advice letter is to notify the California Public Utilities Commission's Water Division that Golden State Water Company (GSWC) does not qualify for and will not be seeking an Escalation Year 2024 increase for its Arden Cordova Customer Service Area (CSA). The rates implemented in this advice letter only include the authorized Cost of Capital rate adjustment for 2024, pursuant to D.23-06-025 and approved in GSWC Advice Letter No. 1910-W.

GSWC's notification to the Water Division is pursuant to Decision No. 23-06-024, dated June 29, 2023, its General Rate Case Application (Application No. 20-07-012).

Specifically, Ordering Paragraph No. 6 of Decision No. 23-06-024 states,

6. For escalation years 2023 and 2024, Golden State Water Company (GSW) must file Tier 1 advice letters in conformance with General Order 96-B proposing new revenue requirements and corresponding revised tariff schedules for each ratemaking area in this proceeding. The advice letters must follow the escalation procedures set forth in the Revised Rate Case Plan for Class A Water Utilities adopted in Decision 07-05-062 and must include supporting workpapers. GSW must file for rate reduction if the escalation procedures result in a rate reduction due to negative rate base growth, inflation factors, or customer growth. The revised tariffs shall be effective as of January 1, 2023, and January 1, 2024, respectively and apply to services rendered on and after their effective dates. The proposed revised revenue requirements and rates must be reviewed by the Commission's Water Division. The Water Division must inform the Commission if it finds that the revised rates do not conform to the Revised Rate Case Plan, this decision, or other Commission decisions, and if so, reject the filing.

RATE OF RETURN

The following summary lists the Recorded, Authorized, Adjusted Authorized, and Pro-forma rates of return in GSWC's Arden Cordova CSA for twelve months ending September 2023. The pro forma rate of return is calculated in accordance with guidelines provided by the Water Division.

Recorded	12.78%
Authorized	6.57%
Adjusted Authorized	6.72%
Pro forma	9.70%

As shown above, the Pro forma rate of return for the 12 months ending September 2023 exceeds GSWC's Adjusted Adopted rate of return, therefore, based on the escalation calculation procedures, Arden Cordova does not qualify for an Escalation Year 2024 rate increase.

As authorized, the rates implemented in this advice letter only include the authorized Cost of Capital rate adjustment for 2024, pursuant to D.23-06-025 and approved in GSWC Advice Letter No. 1910-W. Detailed supporting workpapers are being supplied to the Commission Staff.

EFFECTIVE DATE

GSWC request this advice letter become effective January 1, 2024.

GSWC is not requesting a rate change in this advice letter, therefore, no customer notification is required for this filing.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this Advice Letter (AL). When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

REPLIES

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by the Water Division within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20-day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B.

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. As authorized by Rule 9.1.e. for customers with more than one meter on a single service line, the customer's service charge rate is based on a factor multiplied by the service charge applicable to the nearest standard meter size of the combined meters as determined by the equivalent diameter methodology.
3. Non-residential Sprinkler rates can be added as needed utilizing the multiplication factors identified in Appendix F of Decision 16-12-067, applied to the 5/8" meter charge.
4. Pursuant to Decision 05-07-045, to recover the balance as of January 31, 2005 in the Water Quality Litigation Memorandum Account, a surcharge of \$0.286 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for 20 years. The surcharge amount will be recalculated once in every rate cycle.
5. Pursuant to Decision No. 23-06-024 a surcharge of \$0.107 per Ccf will be applied to all metered Customer bills excluding customers that are receiving the CAP credit. This surcharge will offset the CAP credits and CAP administrative program costs recorded in the CAP Balancing Account.

The surcharge will amortize the cumulative balance recorded in the Tangible Property Regulation Collateral Consequences Memorandum Account as of September 30, 2020.
7. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D.23-06-024, an amount of \$0.0007 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of six months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter No. 1904-W. The surcharge will amortize the cumulative balance recorded in the School Lead Testing Memorandum Account as of September 30, 2020.
8. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D.23-06-024, an amount of \$0.00145 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of six months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter No. 1904-W. The surcharge will amortize the cumulative balance recorded in the Emergency Consumer Protection Memorandum Account as of September 30, 2020.
9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D.23-06-024, an amount of \$0.196 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 36-months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter No. 1909-W. The surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and the final rates for the period of January 1, 2022 through July 30, 2023.
