Summary

GSWC is filing this ministerial advice letter requesting to clean up its tariff schedules and remove special conditions related to surcharges that have expired.

GSWC filed Advice Letter 1899-W (Region 1, excluding Arden Cordova), 1901-W (Region 2), 1903-W (Region 3) and 1904-W (Arden Cordova), in compliance with D.23-06-024 to implement its 2023 rates and also implement various temporary surcharges and sur-credits. All Advice Letters were approved and effective on July 31, 2023.

Request

GSWC is seeking to remove various special conditions related to surcharges implemented with the filing of the above-mentioned advice letters. The surcharges had a 12-month amortization recovery period and have now expired. The removal of these expired special conditions will bring the tariffs up-to-date¹ and will reduce any confusion if customers reference the tariff sheets on the company's website with their monthly bill charges.

Additionally, GSWC is adding a special condition to the residential tariffs in its Region 1 CSAs. The special condition defines residential customers as all single-family customers with one dwelling unit that are individually metered. Currently, this special condition is defined in its Region 2 and Region 3 residential tariffs special conditions; adding this special condition to the Region 1 CSAs will make all residential tariffs consistent.

The filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

Effective Date

GSWC is requesting that this Tier 2 advice letter become effective on October 3, 2024.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter (AL). When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;

- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division (WD) within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform WD, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

<u>Replies</u>

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by WD within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B.
